
WHY SIGN UP FOR DIRECT DEPOSIT?

No need to wait for a check to be mailed home! This direct deposit is different than direct deposit for payroll.

If the college owes your student a refund due to overpayment from a financial aid award, a tuition payment, or reversal of a charge, this credit can be refunded to the student via direct deposit to your bank account.

Step 2: Click on the PAWS Icon in the top center of the menu bar.




- **Step 3:** The student must login with his/her TCNJ username and password.


